SHOW SITE INFORMATION

Food: There may be food available on site. Information will be available closer to the show. Crating: Crating space is limited; no crating in holding area ringside for safety of exhibitors entering/exiting rings. Please help keep show grounds & building clean. Exhibitors will be responsible for their own messes.

LOSS/DAMAGE

The club, show chairperson, show secretary, and club members are not responsible for loss/damage to any dogs exhibited or for the possession of any participant, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody & control of the owner or handler. This also includes the hotels/motels.

SAFETY

If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the club it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. If, in the opinion of the club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors, or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightening or extreme heat, the club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

NOSEWORK

We will offer six nosework trials – two each day.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Pre-Entries

Pre-Entries must be received by September 11, 2026.

Day of Show Entries

Day of Show Entries will be accepted online starting at the close of pre-entries.

Day of Show entries at the show site from 7:30 – 8:00 am each day.

Day of show entries will be online. You may enter online at any time prior to the close of day of show entries – you do not need to be at the show site.

General Entry Information

All entries require payment to be considered a valid entry.

Dogs must be permanently registered with the UKC, have a Temporary Listing number (TL) or have a Performance Listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned. Non-licensed puppies are not required to have a UKC number to compete.

Requests for cancelling entries prior to the closing date will be honored, subject to a \$15 administrative fee. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the pre-entry closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public, or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee.

In the event a female comes into season and cannot compete in a performance event, entry fees will be refunded minus a \$20 administrative fee provided that a veterinary note is provided. Written notice must be given not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any event.

Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. If an exhibitor is not called for their correct class or is called for an incorrect class, it is their responsibility to ask the steward to stop the show and check with the show secretary to correct the error. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.

Pre-entries cannot be modified after the closing of pre-entries other than for move-ups and corrections. If a dog is entered in only some of the shows during a weekend (for example Saturday only) the entry cannot be modified to switch shows (for example switching to Sunday only) even if they are absent for some shows. An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club will add a \$35 fee for each returned check.

The show giving club, their agents, and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property.

Move-Up Information

Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be moved to a different class if a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

Nosework will allow move-ups between trials on the same day or day to day. For day to day move-ups, the request must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at that trial. For same day move-ups, you must see the show secretary before running in the new class. Your ability to move up may be limited by the order of class judging.

All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any regular judging at that show.
